

Dear Seniors and Parents,

Congratulations on your child's upcoming graduation. The next few weeks will be busy so please refer to the following agenda for important dates and times.

Please note that attendance to all of these events is mandatory for all graduating seniors, not only because each day counts as a school day for attendance purposes but also because we will be doing things each day that are important to ensure that our Graduation and Senior Night ceremonies run smoothly and are enjoyable for everyone.

Friday, June 7th - All senior financial obligations must be paid in full. Any senior with unpaid financial obligations (books, locks or any previous year's unpaid debts and food service balances) must be paid in full or they will not be permitted to march at Graduation. Last day of academic classes for seniors.

Monday June 3rd - Friday June 7th: Last week of academic classes, all academic work must be turned in by 2:15 PM on Friday so that graduation status can be assessed. Any senior taking a VLACS course must be completed by 5/31!! In order to complete their transcript for Belmont High School credit.

Friday, June 7th: Senior Breakfast, 8-10 AM -cafeteria. This event is for senior class members only and is a time for them to gather and receive their yearbooks. Seniors will return to classes for the remainder of the day. This is the last day for seniors to complete required courses for graduation. Students who have not met the BHS graduation requirements by 2:15PM will not be permitted to walk in the BHS Graduation Ceremony. Only seniors who have paid in full for their yearbook will receive it on this day.

Monday, June 10th: 8:30 AM-1:30 PM: -CHROMEBOOKS, CHARGERS AND CASES WILL BE COLLECTED! If any of these items are missing, student must pay any incurred charges to participate in Graduation. Graduation rehearsal for ALL Seniors! Caps, gowns and honors sashes/cords will be given out. Class picture will be taken, all seniors will wear their cap & gown for the picture. After graduation seniors may keep their cap & gown, but all Honors and NHS sashes must be returned to Administrators right after graduation, before leaving Meadowbrook!

Wednesday, June 12th: Graduation practice @ Meadowbrook!! 11:30 AM - 2:30 PM. Seniors are responsible for their own transportation to and from Meadowbrook. If this is a problem see Mr. Foley. Bring water and snacks as this practice is long. **PLEASE BE ON TIME! THIS IS OUR ONLY PRACTICE AT MEADOWBROOK.**

Senior Award Night - Thursday, June 13th - BHS GYM, 6:00 PM Seniors meet in BHS cafe at 5:30 PM - seniors should wear their cap & gown! Please dress up-no work boots, no sneakers, collared shirt and pants for males, dress, shirt, dress pants for females. Senior Award Night will include the scholarship and book award presentations.

Friday June 14th - Class Day - BHS gym, 11:50 AM - seniors line up in the cafeteria to march in for class day. Academic medallions to be presented to seniors followed by the NHS Hooding Ceremony. Seniors please arrive to BHS by 11:30 AM for Class Day!! SENIORS ARE TO WEAR THEIR CAP & GOWNS FOR CLASS DAY!! Seniors should dress nicely for this event.

Sunday June 16th: Graduation Ceremony @Meadowbrook 2:00 PM! Seniors should arrive at Meadowbrook by 1:15 PM with cap, gown, sashes and award medallions. Parents may arrive anytime between 1:15 PM to 2:00 PM. Handicapped accessible parking and seating is available at Meadowbrook. There is NO reserved seating at Meadowbrook for parents or anyone. Meadowbrook is a large venue with plenty of seating. No reserved seating allows for parents and families to line up with where their senior is sitting for the best viewing options.

Flower Ceremony: The Class of 2019 will be purchasing 2 carnations (one red, one white) for each graduate, which will be delivered to Meadowbrook. If seniors would like additional flowers to hand out, they are responsible for purchasing and transporting their flowers to Meadowbrook on Sunday afternoon.
